

Silverleaf Shotgun Sports

Rules & Regulations

- Everyone, including spectators, on courses or fields must wear eye & ear protection at all times.
- NO alcoholic beverages allowed on Silverleaf property. Please do not consume alcohol before coming to shoot.
- An adult must accompany and control children at all times while on Silverleaf property.
- Never shoot course “backwards” or skip a station unless directed to do so by management.
- Stay on walkways, and leave all targets broken or whole on the ground.
- Never shoot at wildlife while on Silverleaf property.
- Notify management of trap problems. Do not approach traps.
- Shoot from designated stands or stations only. Do not shoot a station backwards or from out of a stand.
- Keep gun chamber open & empty until in stand and ready to shoot.
- Load no more than two (2) shells at a time.
- The only shot sizes allowed are 7 ½, 8, 8 ½, or 9. The heaviest shot load allowed is 1 1/8 oz. Ammo will be checked!
- Pick up your hulls after squad has completed shooting a station.
- Allow a smaller squad to “playthrough” if they keep catching up.

- There is a 45-minute time limit (for a squad of 5) on the trap, skeet & wobble fields.
Please be considerate of those waiting.
- Check in at Clubhouse before proceeding to another field or course.
- You must be at least 16 years of age or older with a valid drivers license to operate any vehicle on Silverleaf property.
- No horizontal gun racks are allowed on Silverleaf property.
- Please be careful with the controller. Do not carry by or stretch the cord.
- Shotgun barrel must be 18" or longer.

Safety is everyone's responsibility. If you see anyone in non-compliance with the rules or acting in an unsafe manner please notify management immediately.
